Disaster Management – Northeast Monsoon 2023 - Sanction for a sum of Rs.55.00 crore under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) as second and final instalment to the Line Departments towards relief and temporary restoration activities in view of the damages caused due to Cyclone "Michaung" in Chennai, Tiruvallur, Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram Districts - Unprecedented Extremely Heavy Rainfall followed by floods in Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Kanniyakumari and Tenkasi Districts – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the letter third read above, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner has requested to sanction a sum of Rs.250.00 crore under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to the Line Departments towards relief and temporary restoration activities in view of the damages caused due to Cyclone "Michaung" in Chennai, Tiruvallur, Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram Districts and due to the havoc caused because of the Unprecedented Extremely Heavy Rainfall followed by floods in Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Kanniyakumari and Tenkasi Districts.

2. In the Government Order fourth read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.75.00 crore (Rupees Seventy Five Crore only) under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) as first instalment to the Line Departments towards relief and temporary restoration activities in view of the damages caused due to Cyclone "Michaung" in Chennai, Tiruvallur, Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram Districts and due to the havoc caused because of the Unprecedented Extremely Heavy Rainfall followed by floods in Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Kanniyakumari and Tenkasi Districts.

3. Based on the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner for sanction of a total sum of Rs.250 Crore, Rs.75.00 Crore has already been sanctioned in the Government Order fourth read above, and the remaining amount of Rs.175.00 Crore requires to be sanctioned. However, in the minutes of the meeting fifth read above, it has been decided that, some departments shall accommodate the expenditure towards restoration from their own funds and therefore the second and final instalments to be sanctioned as detailed below:
