ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Government of India has released a sum of Rs.408.00.00.000/- to the Government of Tamil Nadu as first installment of the Government of India's contribution to the State Disaster Response fund for the year 2021-2022.

- 2. The Government direct that a sum of Rs.544,00,00,000/- (Rupees five hundred and forty four crore only) comprising first installment of Government of India's contribution of Rs.408,00,00,000/- and the corresponding State's matching contribution of Rs.136,00,00,000/- for the year 2021-2022 be transferred to the State Disaster Response Fund.
