ORDER:

In the letter third read above, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner in its letter dated 18.10.2022 has stated as follows: -

- i. The District Collector, Thoothukudi has sent a proposal for construction of Storm Water Drains in the area from Sankaraperi to Periyapallam Odai along Ettayapuram road in North zone of Thoothukudi Corporation at an estimate cost of Rs.12.00 crore prepared by Thoothukudi Corporation and requested to allocate funds under State Disaster Risk Management Fund (SDRMF).
- ii. The proposal of the District Collector, Thoothukudi was sent to Director of Municipal Administration with a request to offer specific remarks.
- iii. The Director of Municipal Administration, Chennai has stated that the construction of Storm Water Drains in the areas

from Sankaraperi to Periyapallam Odai along Ettayapuram Road has not been taken under any other funds and also recommended to sanction an amount of Rs.12.00 Crore towards the project for construction of Storm Water Drains in the area from Sankaraperi to Periyapallam Odai along Ettayapuram road under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF).

- iv. In view of the above, the proposal of District Collector, Thoothukudi for Rs.12.00 Crore for construction of Storm Water Drains in the area from Sankaraperi to Periyapallam Odai along Ettayapuram road in North zone of Thoothukudi Corporation has been examined and it is eligible under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) and it is recommended to Government for placing the above proposal before the State Executive Committee of Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority (TNSDMA) for obtaining Administrative and Financial sanction under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) window of State Disaster Risk Management Fund (SDRMF).
- 2. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner has therefore requested to sanction a sum of Rs.12.00 Crore under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) towards construction of Storm Water Drains in the area from Sankaraperi to Periyapallam Odai along Ettayapuram road in North zone of Thoothukudi Corporation.
- 3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner and based on the approval of the State Executive Committee, hereby sanction a sum of Rs.12,00,00,000/-(Rupees Twelve Crore only) under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) to the District Collector, Thoothukudi District towards construction of Storm Water Drains in the area from Sankaraperi to Periyapallam Odai along Ettayapuram road in North zone of Thoothukudi Corporation.
- 4. The amount Sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2245 Relief on Account of Natural Calamities 02 Flood, Cyclones, etc., 102 Drinking Water Supply - State's Expenditure AB Storm Water Drains and Water Supply Schemes under Corporations, Local Bodies and Autonomous Bodies 309 Grants-in-Aid 09 others."

5. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" for which the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the

Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawel of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G.I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G.I) Department. He is also directed to send necessary explanatory note to the Government in Finance (B.G.I/ Revenue) Department for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2023-2024 for getting the approval of the Legislature at an appropriate time without fail.
