ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner has sent the proposal for implementing the two flood mitigation works in Kilmonavur village and Kamarajapuram village as follows:-

A. Construction of Flood Protection wall in Palar River right bank in kilmonavur village in Vellore taluk of Vellore District. (Estimate amount: Rs 2.75 Crore)

During the last North East Monsoon in November 2021, in Vellore District sudden realization of more than 1,00,000 cusecs of the flood water damaged right bank of Palar River in Kilmonavur village and erosion took place for a length more than 150m to a height of above 2.00m. It caused damages to the houses adjacent to the bank in Kilmonavur village.

The estimate cost works out to Rs.2.75 Crore as per the current schedule of rates for the year 2022-23.

B. Construction of flood protection wall along the left bank of Palar river at Kamarajapuram Village in K.V.Kuppam taluk of Vellore district. (Estimate amount: Rs.4.25 Crore)

During the last North East Monsoon in November 2021, in Vellore district sudden realization of more than 1,00,000 cusecs of the flood water damaged the Left Bank of Palar River at Kothamanagalam Village (Kamarajapuram) was completely eroded and fully slided. Due to enormous flood, the bund for a length of about 190m to a depth of 6m was completely scoured. Due to this erosion and sliding of Palar River left side bank, more than 15 houses collapsed.

Hence, in order to protect the village from further erosion and sliding of houses, it has been proposed to construct flood protection wall for a length of 190m at the most vulnerable place near Kamarajapuram village.

The estimate cost works out to Rs.4.25 Crore as per the current schedule of rates for the year 2022-23.

By implementing the above two works, the Kilmonavur village and Kamarajapuram village will be protected from further flood damages.

The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner has therefore requested to Administrative and Financial sanction for the above two flood mitigation works under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) allocation for the year 2022-2023 (2nd Instalment) and 2023-2024 as follows:-
 - Construction of Flood Protection wall in Palar River right bank in kilmonavur village in Vellore taluk of Vellore District Estimate amount - Rs.2.75 Crore;

- ii) Construction of Flood protection wall along the left bank of Palar River at Kamarajapuram Village in K.V.Kuppam taluk of vellore District Estimate amount - Rs.4.25 Crore.

It caused damages to the houses adjacent to the bank in Kilmonavur village.

The estimate cost works out to Rs.2.75 Crore as per the current schedule of rates for the year 2022-23.

B. Construction of flood protection wall along the left bank of Palar river at Kamarajapuram Village in K.V.Kuppam taluk of Vellore district. (Estimate amount: Rs.4.25 Crore)

- The Minutes of the State Executive Committee Meeting held on 08.09.2023.

ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner has sent the proposal for implementing the two flood mitigation works in Kilmonavur village and Kamarajapuram village as follows:-

A. Construction of Flood Protection wall in Palar River right bank in kilmonavur village in Vellore taluk of Vellore District. (Estimate amount: Rs 2.75 Crore)

During the last North East Monsoon in November 2021, in Vellore District sudden realization of more than 1,00,000 cusecs of the flood water damaged right bank of Palar River in Kilmonavur village and erosion took place for a length more than 150m to a height of above 2.00m. It caused damages to the houses adjacent to the bank in Kilmonavur village.

The estimate cost works out to Rs.2.75 Crore as per the current schedule of rates for the year 2022-23.

B. Construction of flood protection wall along the left bank of Palar river at Kamarajapuram Village in K.V.Kuppam taluk of Vellore district. (Estimate amount: Rs.4.25 Crore)

During the last North East Monsoon in November 2021, in Vellore district sudden realization of more than 1,00,000 cusecs of the flood water damaged the Left Bank of Palar River at Kothamanagalam Village (Kamarajapuram) was completely eroded and fully slided. Due to enormous flood, the bund for a length of about 190m to a depth of 6m was completely scoured. Due to this erosion and sliding of Palar River left side bank, more than 15 houses collapsed.

Hence, in order to protect the village from further erosion and sliding of houses, it has been proposed to construct flood protection wall for a length of 190m at the most vulnerable place near Kamarajapuram village.

The estimate cost works out to Rs.4.25 Crore as per the current schedule of rates for the year 2022-23.

By implementing the above two works, the Kilmonavur village and Kamarajapuram village will be protected from further flood damages.

- 2. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner has therefore requested to Administrative and Financial sanction for the above two flood mitigation works under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) allocation for the year 2022-2023 (2nd Instalment) and 2023-2024 as follows:-
 - i) Construction of Flood Protection wall in Palar River right bank in kilmonavur village in Vellore taluk of Vellore District Estimate amount - Rs.2.75 Crore;

- ii) Construction of Flood protection wall along the left bank of Palar River at Kamarajapuram Village in K.V.Kuppam taluk of vellore District Estimate amount - Rs.4.25 Crore.
- 3. The State Executive Committee Meeting was conducted by the Chief Secretary to Government on 08.09.2023. In the minutes second read above, the above said proposal was discussed and approved in the meeting as detailed below: -

- 4. The Government after careful examination of the proposals of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner and based on the approval of the State Executive Committee, hereby accord administrative and financial sanction to a sum of Rs.7,00,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore only) under State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) to the Engineer-in-Chief & Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai allocation for the year 2022-2023 (2nd Instalment) and 2023-24 as detailed below: -
 - Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.2,75,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore and Seventy-Five Lakh only) towards construction of Flood Protection wall in Palar River right bank in Kilmonavur village in Vellore taluk of Vellore District;

- Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.4,25,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crore and Twenty Five Lakh only) for construction of Flood protection wall along the left bank of Palar River at Kamarajapuram Village in K.V.Kuppam taluk of vellore District.
- 5. The amount Sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2245 Relief on Account of Natural Calamities 02 Flood, Cyclones, etc., 102 Drinking Water Supply - State's Expenditure AB Storm Water Drains and Water Supply Schemes under Corporations, Local Bodies and Autonomous Bodies 309 Grants-in-Aid 09 others."

[IFHRMS DPC 2245 02 102 AB 30909].

- 6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.7,00,00,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate/ Final Modified Appropriation 2023-2024. Pending provision of such funds, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. This expenditure should be brought to the notice of Legislative Assembly by the way of Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and State Relief Commissioner is directed to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget Proposal for Revised Estimate/ Final Modified Appropriation 2023-2024 and also to send necessary Explanatory Notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024 to Finance (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail.
