Disaster Management – Outbreak of Epidemic COVID-19 – Sanction a sum of Rs.1,30,92,184/- from Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority (TNSDMA) Fund to the District Collector Cuddalore towards the anticipated expenditure for maintenance of COVID CARE Centres and various activities relating to containment of Outbreak of COVID -19 in Cuddalore District - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr.No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view of the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 a pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by the Government of India vide it's Letter Nos. 33-4 / 2020 – NDM-I Dated: 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118 dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. In the letter 8th read above, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the District Collector, Cuddalore has requested to sanction an amount of Rs. 2.00 crore additionally towards incurred and future expenses for COVID CARE Centres to contain the outbreak of COVID-19 in Cuddalore District. In the above proposal the District Collector, Cuddalore has reported as follows:

- In Government order first to fifth read above, the Government have sanctioned the funds to the tune of Rs.6,55,00,000/- (Rupees Six Crore and Fifty Five Lakhs only) under State Disaster Response Fund and Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority to the District Collector, Cuddalore towards the measures for Quarantine, Sample collections and screening to contain the outbreak of COVID-19.
- Out of the above sanction actual expenditure for an amount of Rs.5,73,14,844/- (Rupees Five Crore Seventy Three Lakhs Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Four Four only) so far incurred.
- It is also reported that bills are pending for an amount of Rs.12,77,340/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Seventy Seven Thousand Three Hundred and Forty only) which has to be settled for various Government agencies.
- It is also reported that advance amount of Rs.2.00 crore was sanctioned to District Collector, Cuddalore In G.O. (Ms) No.392, Revenue and Disaster Management DM Wing, DM-II Section, dated 27.07.2020 out of the above sanction an amount of Rs.1,30,92,184/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand One Hundred and Eighty Four Only) has been spent so far towards Institutional Quarantine of Passengers and for accommodating asymptomatic positive patients in Covid Care Centre and creation of new Covid Care Centres.
- It was certified that no amount were claimed under TR-27.
- Also, the District Collector, Cuddalore have reported that up-to 30.09.2020, total number of positive cases reported in Cuddalore District is 20,096. Out of the above 18,259 persons discharged and remaining 1,275 patients, getting treatment in COVID Hospitals and COVID CARE centres.
- Out of the above 1,275 cases 547 persons are accommodated in COVID CARE Centres. It is estimated that a sum of Rs.1,14,87,000/- (One Crore Fourteen Lakhs and Eighty Seven Thousand) (Rs.350 per day X 547 Persons X 60 Days) and Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakhs) towards other expenditure, totally an amount of Rs.1,64,87,000/- is required for the upcoming 2 months.
- In view of the above, the District Collector, Cuddalore has requested to sanction an amount of Rs.2,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore only) towards anticipated expenditure in COVID CARE Centres for the upcoming 2 months in respect of Cuddalore District.

3. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the proposal of the District Collector, Cuddalore has been examined with the SDRF Norms prescribed in G.O Ms No.380 Revenue and Disaster Management Dated: 27.10.2015 and MHA, GOI letter No.33-4/2020-NDM-I Dated 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020. As per Health Department report as on 28.09.2020 number of persons accommodated in COVID CARE centres in Cuddalore District is 494.

4. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has recommended to the State Executive Committee for sanctioning a sum of Rs.1,30,92,184/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand One Hundred and Eighty Four Only) under Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority (TNSDMA) as advance to the District Collector, Cuddalore towards anticipated expenditure for maintenance of COVID CARE Centres and various activities relating to containment of outbreak of COVID-19 in Cuddalore District.

5. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of the State Executive Committee, accord sanction a sum of Rs.1,30,92,184/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand One Hundred and Eighty Four Only) under Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority (TNSDMA) Fund as advance to the District Collector, Cuddalore towards anticipated expenditure for maintenance of COVID CARE Centres and various activities relating to containment of outbreak of COVID-19 in Cuddalore District.

6. The above sanctioned expenditure shall be met out from the Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority Account (TNSDMA) fund as ordered in the Government order sixth read above.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.39427/Finance(Revenue)/2020, dated: 28.10.2020


