ORDER:

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Letter.No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government, keeping in view of the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 a pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India vide its Letter Nos. 33-4/ 2020 – NDM-I Dated: 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118 dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. In the letter fifth read above the Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the District Collector, Tirupattur has requested to sanction an amount of Rs. 1.00 Crore additionally towards incurred and future expenses for COVID CARE Centres to contain the outbreak of COVID-19 in Tirupathur District. He has reported as follows:

- In respect of Tirupattur District the Govt have totally sanctioned an amount of Rs.2.05 Crore towards various activities relates to containment of out-break of COVID-19.
- The above sanctioned amount has also been spent fully towards the various activities relates to containment of out-break of COVID-19.
- Therefore, the District Collector, Tirupattur has requested to sanction an amount of Rs.1.00 crore additionally to meet the future expenses towards COVID care centres.

The above proposal has been examined and it is stated that as on 28.09.2020 the number of positive cases getting treatment in COVID Hospitals and COVID Care centres as detailed below:-

The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the District Collector, Tirupattur has also reported that the sanctioned amount of Rs.2.05 crore has also been utilized fully. As on 27.10.2020 the number of positive cases including home isolation in Tirupattur District is 295. Also, the proposal of the District Collector, Tirupathur has been scrutinized along with SDRF norms prescribed in MHA, GOI letter No.33-4/2020-NDM-I Dated: 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020. In view of the above, funds may be sanctioned to District Collector, Tirupattur towards recurring expenditure for COVID care centres in Tirupattur District as detailed below:-

4. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested to sanction an amount of Rs. 21,56,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakhs Fifty Six Thousand Only) under Tamil

Nadu State Disaster Management Authority towards Recurring expenditure for 220 persons for 4 weeks who were accommodated in COVID CARE Centres in Tirupattur District as detailed below:-
