ORDER:

In the letter ninth read above, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the Government of India by invoking the provisions of Disaster Management Act, 2005 have delegated the powers to the Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to enhance preparedness and containment of novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) and the other

ancillary matters connected thereto vide reference 1st cited. In the letter 2nd cited received from National Disaster Management Authority, it has been requested to identify quarantine and isolation facilities across all the districts within the country and the Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Tamil Nadu has been requested to initiate necessary immediate action in this regard.

2. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the meeting of the Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority was conducted by the Chairman, TNSDMA/ Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 9th, 13th, 16th, 19th and 20th March 2020 to take stock of the situation prevailing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 and issued instructions on containment of Covid-19. Further, based on the press release of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, a sum of Rs.60.00 Crores has been sanctioned to various Line Departments vide the reference 7th cited.

3. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that now, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made an announcement on 23.03.2020 to release the sum of Rs. 500 Crores towards the containment of COVID-19 and the Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118 dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu. In Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr. No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special one time dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 Virus in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India.

4. As per the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, within the overall announcement of Rs.500 crore for Corona Prevention activities, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has requested to sanction a sum of Rs.97 Crores (Rupees Ninety Seven Crores only) from State Disaster Response Fund(SDRF) to the District Administration and Corporations for provision of temporary accommodation and food, clothing, medical care etc., for people affected and sheltered in quarantine camps, cost of disinfectants, cost of consumables for sample collections, support for checking, screening and contact tracing, purchase of masks and personal protection equipments to contain the outbreak of Covid-19 as detailed below:-

Ms. No.246, Revenue Department, dated 03.08.2017 and Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr. No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020.

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu and based on

the approval of State Executive Committee, accord sanction a sum of Rs.97 Crores (Rupees Ninety Seven Crores only) **from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF)** to the District Administration and Corporations for provision of temporary accommodation and food, clothing, medical care etc., for people affected and sheltered in quarantine camps, cost of disinfectants, cost of consumables for sample collections, support for checking, screening and contact tracing, purchase of masks and personal protection equipments to contain the outbreak of Covid-19 as detailed below:-
