ORDER:

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr. No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special one time dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 Virus in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118 dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that

Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. Further, the meeting of the Tamil Nadu State Disaster Management Authority was conducted by the Chairman, TNSDMA/ Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 9th, 13th, 16th, 19th and 20th March 2020 to take stock of the situation prevailing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 and issued instructions on containment of Covid-19.

3. In G.O.Ms.No 194, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, dated 15.4.2020, sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.130.13 crore under State Disaster Response Fund to Labour and Employment department for disbursing Rs.1,000/- each to 13,01,277 registered workers of 15 un-organized Workers Welfare Boards.

4. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that based on the announcement made by Hon'ble Chief Minister on 13.4.2020, Labour and Employment Department issued orders for administration sanction of Rs.130,12,77,000/- under State Disaster Response Fund to provide **second spell** of financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 13,01,277 numbers of registered workers of 15 un-organized Workers Welfare Boards.

5. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore submitted proposal to the State Executive Committee for including Rs.130,12,77,000/- to Labour Department to provide second spell of financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 13,01,277 numbers of registered workers of 15 un-organized Workers Welfare Boards as announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister during the press meet on 13.04.2020 as detailed below:

The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the Director General of Police has stated that the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.3 crores to the Director General of Police for checking, screening and contact tracing, purchase of masks and personnel protection equipment under State Disaster Response Fund and most of the unit officers have spent the money allotted towards the procurement of protective equipment and the Government have extended the prohibitory order till 3rd May, 2020. Therefore the Director General of Police requested an additional fund of Rs.1.5 crore for the procurement of Sanitizers, disinfectants, protective equipment for the Police Personnel engaged in bandobust duty. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested the Government to sanction Rs.1.5 crore to Director General of Police towards procurement of Sanitizers, disinfectants, protective equipment for the Police Personnel engaged in bandobust duty.

7. In pursuant to the G.O. Ms. No.380, Revenue Department, dated 27.10.2015, G.O. Ms. No.246, Revenue Department, dated 03.08.2017 and Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Letter No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has requested that an additional amount of Rs.1.5 crore requested by Director General of Police is found eligible.

8. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee accord sanction following amount from **State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF)** as detailed below:

(i) **Rs.130,12,77,000/-**(Rupees One thirty crore twelve lakhs and seventy seven thousand only) to Labour Department to provide **second spell** of financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 13,01,277 numbers of registered workers of 15 un-organized Workers Welfare Boards as announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister during the press meet on 13.04.2020 :

(ii) Rs.1.5crore (Rupees One crore fifty lakhs only) to Director General of Police towards procurement of Sanitizers, disinfectants, protective equipment for the Police Personnel engaged in bandobust duty.

9. The above expenditure sanctioned in Para 8 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

10. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-21. Pending of such funds, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorised to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2020-21. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-21 and also send necessary explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in Final Supplementary Estimate 2020-21 at appropriate time.
