ORDER:

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Letter No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 Virus in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118 dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the Director General of has stated that the services of 2000 retired BSF and other CAPF is necessary for COVID-19 related bandobust duties for a period of 21 days from 27.04.2020 to 17.05.2020 and the financial implication towards payment of remuneration including feeding charges to the above retired CAPF personnel is as detailed below:

The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the Director General of Police has stated that the Police Department has requisitioned the services of 14,708 Home Guards personnel (12043 men and 2665 women) for bandobust duties from 01.04.2020 to 30.04.2020 (30 days) to help enforce the nationwide lockdown that has been clamped from 24th March onwards to control the spread of COVID-19 and that the feeding charges due to 14,708 Home Guards personnel at the rate of Rs.150 per day for 30 days (from 01.04.2020 to 30.04.2020) for their mobilization and deployment for COVID-19 related works is as detailed below:

4. In pursuant to the G.O. Ms. No.380, Revenue Department, dated 27.10.2015, G.O. Ms. No.246, Revenue Department, dated 03.08.2017 and Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr. No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020 and 28.03.2020, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has requested for a sanction of Rs.3,16,57,500/- (Rupees Three Crores,

Sixteen lakhs, fifty seven thousand and five hundred only) towards payment of remuneration including feeding charges for BSF personnel employed for COVID-19 related duties for 21 days from 27.04.2020 to 17.05.2020 and a sanction of **Rs.6,61,86,000/-**(Rupees Six Crores, sixty one lakhs and Eighty six thousand only) as feeding charges for 14,708 Home Guards deployed for bandobust duties for 30 days from 01.04.2020 to 30.04.2020) to help enforce the nationwide lockdown that has been clamped from 24th March onwards to control the spread of COVID-19 from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).

5. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee accord sanction an additional amount to Director General of Police **from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF)** as detailed below:

- i) **Rs.6,61,86,000/-** (Rupees Six Crore sixty one lakhs and Eighty six thousand only) as feeding charges for 14,708 Home Guards deployed for bandobust duties for 30 days from 01.04.2020 to 30.04.2020.
- ii) **Rs.3,16,57,500/-** (Rupees Three Crore Sixteen lakhs fifty seven thousand and five hundred only) towards payment of remuneration including feeding charges for BSF personnel employed for COVID-19 related duties.

6. The above expenditure sanctioned in Para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

7. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-21. Pending of such funds, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorised to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2020-21. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-21 and

also send necessary explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in Final Supplementary Estimate 2020-21 at appropriate time.
