ORDER:-

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) in the Letter No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 Virus in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118, dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.(Ms) No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.03.2020) have declared that corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that, the District Collector, Vellore has

requested Rs.1,39,09,640 incurred towards purchase of preventive equipments viz., PPEs, Hand Gloves, Gum Boots, Sodium Hypochlorite, Thermal Scanners and towards sample collection, support for checking, screening, sanitation and disinfection activities in all Government Hospitals in Vellore as detailed below:-

Hence, the District Collector Vellore has requested **Rs.3.00 Crore** from SDRF including the settlement of lodge rentals and train fare in respect of 9093 stranded other state CMC patients. Initially an amount of **Rs.2.00 crore** may be sanctioned.

The Collector, Theni has also requested Rs.57.3 lakh towards purchase of tractors and mounted blast sprayers for Theni District as detailed below:-

The District Collector, Tiruvallur has also requested to sanction an amount of Rs.1091.74 lakhs towards establishing infrastructure facilities like Internal roads, Lights, Sanitation arrangements, Drinking water supply, Solid waste management, Disinfection facilities, Hand wash facilities, Food & Refreshments, Security provisions, Health control room, Market Committee administrative facility, District Administration Control Room, ATM / Banking facility, Police Control Room, Fire and Rescue, Signage boards, Workers waiting shed, Drivers waiting shed in the temporary vegetable market functioning in Thirumazhisai Satellite town as detailed below:-

3. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated that the above proposals were examined with Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, Letter No.33-4/2020-NDM-I, datd 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020, it is found eligible and requested to sanction **Rs.2.00 crore to Vellore District** towards Purchase of PPE, Sanitation and cost of lodge rent and train fare of stranded other State Patients, **Rs. 57.30 lakh to Theni District** towards Purchase of tractors and mounted blast sprayers, **Rs.10.9174 crore to Tiruvallur District** towards setting up of Vegetable market at Thirumazhisai to control the spread of COVID-19 respectively from the State Disaster Response Fund.

4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee accord sanction for a sum of Rs.13,49,04,000 (Rupees Thirteen crore Forty Nine lakhs and Four Thousand only) from SDRF as detailed below:-

- (i) **Rs.2.00 crore to the District Collector, Vellore District** towards Purchase of PPE, Sanitation and cost of lodge rent and train fare of stranded other State Patients.
- (ii) **Rs. 57.30 lakh to the District collector Theni District** towards Purchase of tractors and mounted blast sprayers.
- (iii) **Rs.10.9174 crore to the District collector Tiruvallur District** towards setting up of Vegetable market at Thirumazhisai to control the spread of COVID-19.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2245 - Relief on Account of Natural Calamities - 80 General - 800 Other expenditure State's Expenditure-AH-Disaster Preparedness / Preventive measures to contain the outbreak of Corona Virus (Covid 19) - 309 Grants-in-Aid - 09 Others

6. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/ FMA 2020-21. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2020-21. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-21 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-21 to Finance [BG-I/ Revenue] Department without fail at an appropriate time.
