ORDER:-

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr.No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 Virus in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India vide it's Letter No.s 33-4 / 2020 – NDM-I Dated: 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118 dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. In the reference 4th read above the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the District

Collectors of Kancheepuram, Chengalpattu and Tiruvallur have requested funds for quarantine of International Travellers/Passengers, for a period of 14 days from the date of their arrival as detailed below:-

The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the rates given by the District Collectors, Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram, Tiruvallur for each person are detailed below. On 15.05.2020 Additional Chief Secretary, Finance Department after detailed discussion with Principal Secretary, Public Works Department, Principal Secretary, Housing & Urban Development Department, Commissioner of Revenue Administration, Commissioner of Greater Chennai Corporation, Commissioner [Disaster Management] (FAC), Deputy Commissioner (works), Greater Chennai Corporation and Deputy Secretary (Budget), finalized the standard cost based on rates adopted by the Medical Services Corporation, the rates mentioned in the District Collector proposals at market rate as detailed below:-

4. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration also stated that as on 18.05.2020, 610 foreign returned passengers were quarantined in Chengalpattu District only. Hence, purchase of permanent items may be restricted to 1000 numbers and cost of quarantine may be sanctioned for 1000 in Kancheepuram & Tiruvallur and 2000 in Chengalpattu as detailed below (As per cost arrived):-
