ORDER:

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr.No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has

been informed that the Central Government keeping in view of the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 Virus in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India vide it's Letter No.s 33-4/2020-NDM-I, dated: 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118, dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. In G.O.Ms.No.189, Revenue and Disaster Management (DM II) Dept., Dated 11.04.2020, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.86.05 Crore (Rupees Eighty Six Crores and Five lakhs only) from SDRF as first spell to disburse ex-gratia of Rs.1000/- to registered board members who were affected due to the lockdown to control spread of COVID-19. Subsequently additional amount was sanctioned in G.O.(Ms)No.211, Revenue and Disaster Management (DM II) Dept., dated 28.04.2020. In G.O.(Ms)No.233, Revenue and Disaster Management (DMII) Dept., dated 12.05.2020 the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs. 83.995 crore under the SDRF as second spell to disburse ex-gratia of Rs.1000/- to registered board members who were affected due to the lockdown to control spread of COVID-19.

3) The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu made Announcement on 15.06.2020 to extend the assistance of Rs.1,000/- to all the registered members of the Boards within the area of **Greater Chennai Police Commissionerate area, In Thiruvallur District**-Greater Chennai Police Commissionerate areas in Thiruvallur District, Thiruvallur Municipality, Gummindipoondi, Ponneri and Minjur Town Panchayats, all village panchayats in Poovirundhavalli, Eekadu and Sholavaram blocks, in **Chengalpattu District**, Greater Chennai Police areas in Chengalpattu District, Chengalpattu and Maraimalai Nagar Municipalities, Nandhivaram-Guduvanchery Town Panchayat and all Village Panchayats of Kattankulathur Block and Greater Chennai Police Commissionerate areas in Kancheepuram District.

4. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested the orders of the Government to sanction the following amounts from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to 7 registered Welfare Board from 19.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 as detailed below:-

- i. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs. 15,29,000/- (Rupees Fifteen lakhs and twenty nine thousand only)** to the Director of Backward class and De-notified communities to provide financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to Narikuravars, De-notified communities and Ulemass and employees Welfare Board from the unspent balance amount of Rs. 4,62,78,000/-.

Further the Director of Backward class and De-notified communities may be directed to remit the remaining amount of Rs.4,47,49,000/- (Rupees Four crore forty seven lakhs and forty nine thousand only) into the relevant head of account.

- ii. Administrative sanction to utilize the unspent balance of **Rs. 3,78,80,000/- (Rupees Three crore seventy eight lakhs and eighty thousand only)** and financial sanction for an amount of **Rs. 1,60,56,000/- (Rupees One crore sixty lakhs and Fifty six thousand only)** to the Director of Fisheries, Chennai for disbursement of ex-gratia amount to the 53,936 fishermen belongs to Tiruvallur, Chennai, Kancheepuram and Chengalpattu Districts.
- iii. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs.62,000/- (Rupees Sixty two thousand only)** to the Director of Adi-dravidar welfare, Chennai from the funds available in the General account of Pudurai vannar welfare board to provide financial assistance of Rs.1000/- each to it's 62 members.
- iv. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs.3,61,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs and Sixty one Thousand only)** to the Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment to provide financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 361 members of Poosaries welfare board from the unspent balance of Rs.1,93,48,000/-.

Further, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment may be directed to remit the remaining balance of Rs.1,89,87,000/- (Rupees One crore eighty nine lakhs and eighty seven thousand only) in to the relevant head of account.

- v. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs.74,000/- (Rupees Seventy four thousand only)** to the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi & Village Industries Board to provide financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 74 members of Khadi spiners and weavers welfare board from the unspent balance of Rs.7,28,000/-

Further the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi & Village Industries Board may be directed to remit the remaining balance of Rs.6,54,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs and Fifty four thousand only) in to the relevant head of account.

5.The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee ordered the following:-

- i. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs. 15,29,000/- (Rupees Fifteen lakhs and twenty nine thousand only)** to the Director of Backward class and De-notified communities to provide financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to Narikuravars, De-notified communities and Ulemass and employees Welfare Board from the unspent balance amount of Rs. 4,62,78,000/-.

Further the Director of Backward class and De-notified communities is directed to remit the remaining amount of Rs.4,47,49,000/- (Rupees Four crore forty seven lakhs and forty nine thousand only) into the relevant head of account.

- ii. Administrative sanction to utilize the unspent balance of **Rs. 3,78,80,000/- (Rupees Three crore seventy eight lakhs and eighty thousand only)** available with Director of Fisheries and financial sanction for an amount of **Rs. 1,60,56,000/- (Rupees One crore sixty lakhs and Fifty six thousand only)** to the Director of Fisheries, Chennai for disbursement of ex-gratia amount to the 53,936 fishermen belongs to Tiruvallur, Chennai, Kancheepuram and Chengalpattu Districts.
- iii. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs.62,000/- (Rupees Sixty two thousand only)** to the Director of Adi-draavidar welfare, Chennai from the funds available in the General account of Pudhirai vannar welfare board to provide financial assistance of Rs.1000/- each to it's 62 members.

- iv. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs.3,61,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs and Sixty one Thousand only)** to the Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment to provide financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 361 members of Pooaries welfare board from the unspent balance of Rs.1,93,48,000/-.

Further, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment is directed to remit the remaining balance of Rs.1,89,87,000/- (Rupees One crore eighty nine lakhs and eighty seven thousand only) in to the relevant head of account.

- v. Administrative sanction for an amount of **Rs.74,000/- (Rupees Seventy four thousand only)** to the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi & Village Industries Board to provide financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 74 members of Khadi spiners and weavers welfare board from the unspent balance of Rs.7,28,000/-

Further the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi & Village Industries Board is directed to remit the remaining balance of Rs.6,54,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs and Fifty four thousand only) in to the relevant head of account.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.1,60,56,000/- (Rupees One crore sixty lakh fifty six thousand only) will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-21. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2020-21. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-21 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for

specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-21 to Finance (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail at an appropriate time.
