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#### ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view the spread of COVID-19 in India and the declaration of COVID-19 a pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF and the list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118, dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department,

dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.
