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**ORDER:**

In the letter first read above, Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) has informed that the Central Government keeping in view the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118 dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

2. In the letter fourteenth read above, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that, in view of out-break of COVID-19 disease, in the Government Orders fourth and eighth read above, Government have sanctioned an amount of Rs.130,12,77,000/- (Rupees one hundred and thirty crore twelve lakhs and seventy seven thousand only) each towards the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> spell of financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 13,01,277 numbers of registered workers of 15 un-organized Workers Welfare Boards under State Disaster Response Fund to Labour and Employment department. Further, in the Government Order tenth read above, an amount of Rs.2,48,46,000/- was sanctioned towards disbursement of financial assistance of Rs.1000/- for two spells to the remaining 12,423 registered workers of Tamil Nadu Street Vending and Shops & Establishments workers welfare board.

3. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that, in continuation to the above, the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Labour and Employment Department has requested the financial sanction of Rs.9,92,80,000/- (Rupees Nine crore ninety two lakh and eighty thousand only) under State Disaster Response Fund to provide financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 99,280 numbers of Registered workers of 15 un-organized Workers Welfare Boards in Chennai and certain parts of Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur and Chengalpattu district where lock-down was extended as announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister.

4. In this connection, the details of utilization of the funds sanctioned towards 1<sup>st</sup> spell and 2<sup>nd</sup> spell sought from the Labour and Employment Department. The Secretary, Tamil Nadu Manual Workers Social Security and Welfare Board has stated that there is a total undisbursed amount of Rs.15,45,24,000/- available as detailed below:-

The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has recommended the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary, Labour and Employment Department and requested administrative sanction for utilizing a sum of Rs.9,92,80,000/- (Rupees Nine crore ninety two lakh and eighty thousand only) from the unspent amount already sanctioned in the Government Orders fourth, eighth and tenth read above under State Disaster Response Fund to Labour Department to provide 3<sup>rd</sup> spell of financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- each to 99,280 numbers of registered workers of 15 un-organized Workers Welfare Boards in Chennai and certain parts of Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur and Chengalpattu district where lock-down was extended as announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister as detailed below:-
