### ORDER:

In the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division) Lr.No.33-4/2020/NDM-1, dated 14.3.2020, it has been informed that the Central Government keeping in view of the spread of COVID-19 Virus in India and the declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), by way of a special onetime dispensation, has decided to treat it as a notified disaster for the purpose of providing assistance under SDRF. The list of norms of assistance for containment of COVID-19 Virus in India, eligible from SDRF has also been communicated by Government of India vide it's Letter No.S33-4/2020-NDM-I, dated: 14.03.2020 and 28.03.2020. The Government of Tamil Nadu vide its Notification No.118, dated 14.03.2020, (G.O.Ms.No.95, Health and Family Welfare (P1) Department, dated 13.3.2020) have declared that Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a notified disease in the State of Tamil Nadu.

 In the reference 3rd cited, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration, has stated that the Director General of Police / Head of Police towards feeding charges for Police Personnel under State Disaster Response Fund towards various activities relates to COVID-19 as detailed below:-

- Administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.59,30,86,000/(Rupees Fifty Nine Crore Thirty lakhs and Eighty Six Thousand only) and utilize the savings amount of Rs.9,21,89,850/(Rupees Nine Crore Twenty One Lakh Eighty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty only) and release balance amount of Rs.50,08,96,150/- (Rupees Fifty Crore Eight Lakhs Ninety Six Thousand One Hundred and Fifty only) towards feeding charges at the rate of Rs.250/per day for a maximum of 26 days (excluding 4 day ETR for 4 Sundays) for the period from 01.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 to the 91,244 from the rank of Gr.II PCs to Inspectors of Police contain the spread of COVID-19 from State Disaster Response Fund.
- ii. Sanction a sum of Rs.23,10,000/- (Rupees Twenty Three Lakhs and Ten Thousand only) towards feeding charges at the rate of Rs.200/- per day for 30 days from 01.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 to the 385 nos. of Cooks/ Dhobies/ Barbers/ Sanitary workers) from State Disaster Response Fund towards the COVID-19 related activities.
- 3. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration in his letter, dated 30.07.2020 has stated that the DGP / Head of the Police Force has informed that the actual strength utilized for the COVID-19 bandobust duty form 01.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 as detailed below:-

- 4. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested to Government to sanction the following:
  - i. Administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.57,20,00,000/-(Rupees Fifty Seven Crore and Twenty Lakhs only) and utilize the savings amount of Rs.9,21,89,850/- (Rupees Nine Crore Twenty One Lakh Eighty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty only) and release balance amount of Rs. 47,98,10,150/- (Rupees Forty Seven Crore Ninety Eight Lakhs Ten Thousand One Hundred and Fifty only) under SDRF towards feeding charges at the rate of Rs.250/per day for a maximum of 26 days (excluding 4 day ETR for 4 Sundays) for the period from 01.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 to the 88,000 Local / AR / TSP special units police personnel's from the rank of Gr.II PCs to Inspectors of Police to contain the spread of COVID-19.
  - ii. A sum of Rs.23,10,000/- (Rupees Twenty Three Lakhs and Ten Thousand only) towards feeding charges at the rate of Rs.200/- per day for 30 days from 01.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 to the 385 nos. of followers (Cooks / Dhobies / Barbers / Sanitary workers) from State Disaster Response Fund towards the COVID-19 related activities.
- 5. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the revised proposal of the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of the State Executive Committee and accord Administrative and financial sanction for the following to Director General of Police/Head of Police from State Disaster Response Fund:-
  - Rupees Fifty Seven Crore and Twenty Lakhs only) and utilize the savings amount of Rs.9,21,89,850/- (Rupees Nine Crore Twenty One Lakh Eighty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty only) and sanction the balance amount of Rs.47,98,10,150/- (Rupees Forty Seven Crore Ninety Eight Lakhs Ten Thousand One Hundred and Fifty only) under SDRF towards feeding charges at the rate of Rs.250/-per day for a maximum of 26 days (excluding 4 day ETR for 4 Sundays) for the period from 01.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 to the 88,000 Local / AR / TSP special units police personnel's from the rank of Gr.II PCs to Inspectors of Police to contain the spread of COVID-19.

- ii. Sanction a sum of Rs.23,10,000/- (Rupees Twenty Three Lakhs and Ten Thousand only) towards feeding charges at the rate of Rs.200/- per day for 30 days from 01.06.2020 to 30.06.2020 to the 385 nos. of followers (Cooks / Dhobies / Barbers / Sanitary workers) from State Disaster Response Fund towards the COVID-19 related activities.
- 6. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2245-Relief on Account of Natural Calamities - 80- General -800-Other expenditure State's Expenditure - AH-Disaster Preparedness / Preventive measures to contain the outbreak of Corona Virus (Covid 19) - 309-Grants-in-Aid - 09-Others (Old DPC 2245-80-800-AH-0998) (IFHRMS DPC 2245-80-800-AH-30909)

- 7. Necessary additional funds Rs.48,21,20,150/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-21. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2020-21. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-21 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for specific 2020-21 to **Estimate** Supplementary the in (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail at an appropriate time.
