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### **ORDER:**

In the reference 5<sup>th</sup> read above, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the District Collector, Tiruvallur has informed that in order to supply of Bed sheets to the flood-affected victims accommodated in relief camps during Vardha cyclone - 2016, 4060 Nos. of bed sheets have been purchased from Co-optex at the rate of Rs.287.40/- per bed sheet and supplied to them. The Regional Manager, Co-optex has submitted the bill for Rs.11,66,844/- towards supply of above said number of Bed sheets and requested to settle the amount to the Co-optex and requested for allotment of fund to settle the above said amount.

2. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the above proposal has been examined in detailed with the Government order 1<sup>st</sup> read above and it is eligible for sanction under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) as shown below:-

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Hence the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has requested to sanction a sum of Rs.11,66,844/- from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to the District Collector, Tiruvallur for settlement of dues to the

Tamil Nadu Handloom Weaver's Co-operative Society Ltd., (Co-optex) towards supply of 4060 Number of bed sheets, to the flood-affected victims who were accommodated in relief camps at Ponneri Taluk in Tiruvallur District during Vardah cyclone - 2016.

3. The Government after careful consideration, accept the Proposal of the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of the State Executive Committee accord sanction a sum of Rs.11,66,844/- (Rupees Eleven lakhs sixty six thousand eight hundred and forty four Only) from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to the District Collector, Tiruvallur for settlement of dues to the Tamil Nadu Handloom Weaver's Co-operative Society Ltd., (Co-optex) towards supply of 4060 Number of bed sheets to the flood-affected victims who were accommodated in relief camps at Ponneri Taluk in Tiruvallur District during Vardah cyclone - 2016.

4. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

**"2245 Relief on account of Natural Calamities – 02 Flood, Cyclones etc. - 101 Gratuitous Relief – State's Expenditure - AB Distribution of free supply of Rice, Cloth, Food, Kerosene etc. in flood affected areas - 324 Materials and supplies 01 – Materials and supplies"**

5. Necessary additional funds of Rs.11,66,844/- will be provided in FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds, the Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by Specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021. The Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to send necessary proposal for inclusion of the expenditure in 2020-2021 and also to send necessary draft Explanatory Note for specific inclusion in the supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail at appropriate time.
