ORDER:

The Government, in the Government Order third read above, sanctioned a sum of Rs.14,58,66,930/- for procurement of Equipments and Rs.41,33,070/- for imparting training, totally Rs.15,00,00,000/- from State Disaster Response Fund to the Inspector General of Police Operations and Tamil Nadu Disaster Response Force (TNDRF), Chennai.

2. In the letter fourth read above, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that, the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu has submitted that the State of Tamil Nadu has faced the onslaught of the North East Monsoon since 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 which emphasizes the need for making preparatory arrangements for man-made and natural disasters. Tamil Nadu Disaster Response Force personnel are trained in basic disaster management techniques, namely, Medical, First Responder, Collapsed structure – Search and Rescue and Flood Water Rescue Operations, etc., as a mandatory requirement. A contingent of personnel trained on basic disaster management techniques have also to be trained on certain specialized skills such as Maintenance Technician Course, Advanced Technical

Rescue Course, Basic Deep Diving Course, etc., so as to handle specialized operations in dealing with hazardous situations arising out of both man-made and natural disasters. In view of the experience gained and the difficulties faced in the recent rescue works carried out at the Nilgiris District during the recent landslides, Tsunami Mock Drill, etc., the need of certain advanced and specialized equipments were noticed. Hence, he has proposed to procure certain advanced equipments including boats and special vehicles as detailed below:-

3. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the provision of the specialized equipments will certainly strengthen the responsive arm of Tamil Nadu Disaster Response Force (TNDRF) and the proposal of the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu has been examined with reference to SDRF norms prescribed in the Government Order first read above, and requested to sanction a sum of Rs.10,14,82,700/- from SDRF towards Procurement of advanced and specialized Search, rescue and evacuation equipments for Tamil Nadu Disaster Response Force.

4. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.10,14,82,700/- (Rupees Ten Crore and Fourteen Lakhs Eighty Two Thousand Seven Hundred Only) from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards Procurement of advanced and

specialized Search, rescue and evacuation equipments for Tamil Nadu Disaster Response Force.

5. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2245 - Relief on account of Natural Calamities – 80 General - 102 Management Natural Disasters Contingency Plan in Disaster prone areas State's Expenditure – AD Tamil Nadu Disaster Response Force - 319 Machinery and Equipments – 01 Purchase.
