ORDER:

In the letter fifth read above the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the Engineer-in-Chief, WRD., & Chief Engineer (General), PWD., Chepauk, Chennai has forwarded the list of Temporary and Permanent Restoration works for the flood damages which occurred during the South West Monsoon 2018 in Kanniyakumari District for an amount Rs.242.00 lakh received from the District Collector, Kanniyakumari District, for necessary action. The Collector, Kanniyakumari in his letter second read above has informed that the flood in Kanniyakumari district on 15.08.2018 caused damages to Roads, Bridges/Culverts, Channels, Tanks, Ponds, Drain, Water Supply pipe lines, CWSS, Buildings, etc. Rain water entered in the low lying area causing inundation in several hamlets in the district. Drinking water supply was provided using tanker lorries in the affected areas. The

damage assessment reports received from Public Works Department (WRO) are furnished below:-

2. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the District Collector, Kanniyakumari has requested to allot an amount of Rs.242.00 lakh for immediate temporary restoration work and the request of the District Collector, Kanniyakumari covered under the State Disaster Response Fund as per the norms prescribed in the Government order first read above.

3. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated that he has recommended to sanction Rs.242.00 lakh (Rupees Two hundred and Fourty Two Lakhs only) to PWD/WRO from the Stated Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) funds for immediate temporary restoration work which was damaged due to Heavy rainfall on 15.08.2018 and 16.08.2018 in Kanniyakumari District. Accordingly, the Government in the Government Order fourth read above have sanctioned a sum of Rs.2,42,00,000/- from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) funds for the same.

4. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated that due to COVID-19 lockdown, the amount was not drawn and disbursed to the Public Works Department (WRD) before the end of the financial year i.e.31.03.2020 and therefore requested to revalidate the G.O.Ms.No.163, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, dated 19.03.2020 to enable his office to draw and disburse the amount to Public Works Department (WRD).

5. The Government, after careful consideration of the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee hereby revalidate the Government order fourth read above and authorise the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration to release an amount of Rs.2,42,00,000 (Two crore forty two lakh only) from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to the Public Works Department (WRD) towards temporary restoration works carried out for the damage occurred due to heavy rain fall on 15.08.2018 and 16.08.2018 in Kanniyakumari District.

6. The amount sanctioned in Para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2245 Relief on account of Natural Calamities - 02- Floods, Cyclones etc.
- 122 - Repairs and restoration of damaged Irrigation and Flood Control Works - State's Expenditure - AE - Repairs and Restoration works under Public Works Department (Water Resources Department)- 317-Minor Works - 01-Minor Works.

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2,42,00,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislative Assembly by Specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to sent necessary proposal for inclusion on the expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-2021 and also to send necessary draft Explanatory Note for specific inclusion in the supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail at appropriate time.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.21262/Finance (Revenue)/2020, dated 15.07.2020 with A.S.L.No.195 (One hundred and ninety five).


