ORDER:

In the letter 4th read above, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the District Collector, Tiruppur has sent proposals to the Director of Agriculture, Chennai to sanction an amount of Rs.5,765/- towards input subsidy relief assistance to the affected Coconut farmer Thiru Aiyyasamy S/O Ramasamy whose Coconut trees (56 No's) were damaged due to fire accident on 08.09.2018 in his farm field situated in Survey number 433/1 and 432 of Vadugapalayam Village, Dharapuram Taluk of Tiruppur District. In this connection the Director of Agriculture has recommended the above proposals and requested to sanction an amount of Rs. 5,765/- as detailed below.

2. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the proposals of the District Collector, Tiruppur along with the recommendation of the Director of Agriculture Department has been examined in detail with reference to

norms prescribed in the G.O. first read above Under Agriculture relief Sl. No. (b) (ii) of the above said G.O., there is a provision for sanction of funds of Rs. 18,000 /- per hectare for all type of perennial crops under the head of input subsidy where crop loss is 33% and above (for Agriculture Crops, Horticulture Crops and Plantation Crops) due to disaster under SDRF. Hence, in the light of the above said SDRF provision the request of the District Collector, Tiruppur, is found eligible to provide input subsidy relief assistance.

3. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested orders of the government to sanction a sum of Rs.5,765 /- from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to provide input subsidy relief assistance to the affected Coconut farmer Thiru Aiyasamy S/O Ramasamy whose Coconut trees (56 numbers) were damaged due to fire accident occurred on 08.09.2018 in his farm field situated in Survey numbers 433/1 and 432 of Vadugapalayam Village, Dharapuram Taluk of Tiruppur District.

4. The Government, after careful consideration of the proposal of the District Collector Tiruppur as recommended by the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee, accord sanction a sum of Rs.5,765 /- (Rupees Five thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Five Only) from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to provide input subsidy relief assistance to the affected Coconut farmer Thiru Aiyasamy S/O Ramasamy whose Coconut trees (56 numbers) were damaged due to fire accident occurred on 08.09.2018 in his farm field situated in Survey numbers 433/1 and 432 of Vadugapalayam Village, Dharapuram Taluk of Tiruppur District.

5. The amount sanctioned in Para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2245 Relief on Account of Natural Calamities – 80 General – 800 Other Expenditure – State's Expenditure – AA Assistance for undertaking immediate relief works in connection with Flood/ Fire/ Drought 351 compensation 02 other compensations – Voted".

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.5765/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of funds in RE/FMA 2020-2021, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above. The principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is also directed to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget Proposal for RE/FMA 2020-2021, to Finance (Revenue) Department without fail.
