Disaster Management - Heavy to very rain with extreme intensity is likely to occur from 4th to 8th august 2020 - Sanction an amount of Rs.80,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty Lakhs Only) from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards engagement of JCBs' and other emergency vehicles for evacuation of the people who are stranded in hilly areas - Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the letter third read above, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the District Collector, The Nilgiris has requested to sanction an amount of Rs.80.00 Lakhs towards various activities relates to temporary restoration work to tackle the unprecedented rainfall in the Nilgiris District. He has also reported that the Indian Regional Meteorological center has issued weather forecast for the Nilgiris stating that heavy to very rain with extreme intensity is likely to occur from 4th to 8th august 2020. As a precautionary step, the District Administration decided to evacuate people living in highly vulnerable locations and low lying areas identified to avert loss of lives. Therefore, the District Collector, the Nilgiris has requested to sanction an amount of Rs.80,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty Lakhs Only) to engage JCBs' and other emergency vehicles for the evacuation work for the current year.

2. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further that the proposal of the District Collector, the Nilgiris has been examined in detail with the SDRF norms prescribed Sl. Nos. 11 of the Annexure, in the Government Order first read above, there is a provision for sanction of funds under the Procurement of essential search, rescue and evacuation equipments Head from the SDRF.

3. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested the Government for passing orders to sanction an amount

of Rs.80,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty Lakhs Only) towards engagement of JCBs' and other emergency vehicles for evacuation of the people who are stranded in hilly areas due to unprecedented rainfall in the Nilgiris District.

4. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee, accord sanction a sum of Rs.80,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty Lakhs Only) under SDRF towards engagement of JCBs' and other emergency vehicles for evacuation of the people who are stranded in hilly areas due to unprecedented rainfall in the Nilgiris District.

5. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.80,00,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Secretary /Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. This expenditure should be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration is also directed to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the budget proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2020-2021 and also to send necessary explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021 to Finance (BG.I/Revenue) Department at appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.29595/Finance (Revenue)/2020, dated 12.09.2020 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.506 (Five hundred and six)
