



### ABSTRACT

Disaster Management – "NIVAR" Cyclone - Providing **10 Kilo Rice, 1 Saree and 1 Dhoti, 1 Litre Oil, 1 Kilo Dhal and 1 Litre Kerosene** to **71,902 families** who have been affected and evacuated and sheltered in relief camps due to NIVAR Cyclone - Sanction a sum of Rs.5,75,89,925/- from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) – Orders – Issued.

### ORDER:

In the Press statement third read above, the Hon'ble Chief Minister among others made the following announcement:-

"XXXXX 'நிவர்' புயல் காரணமாக, தாழ்வான பகுதிகளில் வசிக்கும் நபர்கள் எவ்வித பாதிப்புக்கும் உள்ளாகாமல் இருக்க, அங்கிருந்து பாதுகாப்பாக வெளியேற்றப்பட்டு நிவாரண முகாம்களில் தங்க வைக்கப்பட்டனர். அவர்களுக்குத் தேவையான உணவு, குடிநீர், பாய், போர்வை உள்ளிட்ட அத்தியாவசியப் பொருட்கள் வழங்கப்பட்டுள்ளன. மேலும், குடும்பம் ஒன்றிற்கு 10 கிலோ அரிசி, ஒரு வேட்டி, ஒரு சேலை மற்றும் ஒரு லிட்டர் மண்ணெண்ணெய் வழங்கப்பட்டு வருகிறது. இது தவிர ஒரு கிலோ பருப்பும், சமையல் எண்ணெயும் வழங்க உத்தரவிட்டேன்".

2. In the letter sixth read above, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that 'Nivar' cyclone crossed the Tamil Nadu and Puducherry Coast near Puducherry between 23.30 Hrs of 25.11.2020 and 02.30 Hrs of 26.11.2020. Its track was continuously followed till it crossed the border of Tamil Nadu. Few coastal districts as well as certain interior districts received rainfall coupled with cyclonic wind gusting up to 120-130 kmph which left trees uprooted, power transmission lines disrupted, water stagnating at many places and normal life was thrown out of gear.

3. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated that due to 'Nivar' cyclone, the Collectors was instructed to evacuate the families from low lying and vulnerable areas as a measure of preparedness on the basis of various warning and alerts received from IMD time to time. Accordingly, it has been reported that 71,902 families (2,27,442 persons in 3,040 relief camps) were evacuated and shifted to relief centers in 18 districts (Ariyalur, Chengalpattu, Chennai, Cuddalore, Kallakurichi, Kancheepuram, Nagapattinam, Perambalur, Pudukottai, Ranipet, Sivaganga, Thanjavur, Tirupattur, Tiruvallur, Tiruvannamalai, Tiruvarur, Vellore and Villupuram).

4. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated as follows:-

(i) The Director of Handlooms and Textiles has furnished the cost for the Saree and Dhoti as follows: -

5. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that an amount required for **10 Kilo Rice, 1 Saree and 1 Dhoti, 1 Litre Oil, 1 Kilo Dhal and 1 Litre Kerosene** to 71,902 families who have been evacuated and sheltered in relief camps due to NIVAR Cyclone, as detailed below:-

6. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the norms prescribed in the Government Order first read above for providing relief measures to the inmates who were evacuated and sheltered in relief camps are as follows:-

3	RELIEF MEASURES a) Provision for temporary accommodation, food, clothing, medical care, etc., for people affected / evacuated and sheltered in relief camps.	A package of 10 KG rice, one saree and one dhoti, one litre of kerosene and Rs.1000/- to the families evacuated from their houses and moved to shelters.

In addition to the **10 Kilo Rice, 1 Saree & 1 Dhoti, 1 Litre Kerosene** is further required to provide **1 Litre Oil and 1 Kilo Dhal** as a Special Package to 71,902 families sheltered in relief camps.

7. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested the Government to sanction the following:-

- a) To permit to provide **1 Litre Oil and 1 Kilo Dhal** in addition to the **10 Kilo Rice, 1 Saree & 1 Dhoti, 1 Litre Kerosene prescribed in the norms for SDRF** as a Special Package to 71,902 families sheltered in relief camps due to NIVAR Cyclone.
- b) To sanction Rs.5,75,89,925/- (Rupees Five Crore Seventy Five Lakhs Eighty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Five only) for providing **10 Kilo Rice, 1 Saree & 1 Dhoti, 1 Litre Oil, 1 Kilo Dhal and 1 Litre Kerosene** to **71,902 families** who have been affected and evacuated and sheltered in relief camps due to NIVAR Cyclone.

8. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee, accord sanction for the following:-

- a) To provide **1 Litre Oil and 1 Kilo Dhal** in addition to the **10 Kilo Rice, 1 Saree & 1 Dhoti, 1 Litre Kerosene prescribed in the norms for SDRF** as a Special Package to 71,902 families sheltered in relief camps due to NIVAR Cyclone.
- b) Accord sanction for a sum of Rs.5,75,89,925/- (Rupees Five Crore Seventy Five Lakhs Eighty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Five only) from State Disaster Response Fund for providing **10 Kilo Rice, 1 Saree & 1 Dhoti, 1 Litre Oil, 1 Kilo Dhal and 1 Litre Kerosene** to **71,902 families** who have been affected and evacuated and sheltered in relief camps due to NIVAR Cyclone.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 8 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

10. Necessary additional funds of Rs.5,75,89,925/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in Supplementary

Estimate 2020-2021. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-21 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail at an appropriate time.
