ORDER:

In the reference 2nd read above, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the NDMA has decided to implement the National Disaster Management Service (NDMS) Pilot Project under the Other Disaster Management Project (ODMP) Scheme for provisioning of Satellite based Communication Network along with other equipment at

1. State Emergency Operation Center (SEOC) at Chennai
2. District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC) at Kancheepuram
3. District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC) at Tiruvallur
4. District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC) at Tirunelveli

In the State of Tamil Nadu to provide reliable telecommunication infrastructure and technical support to the SEOC & DEOCs to have uninterrupted communication between various EOCs of State, NDMA, MHA, NDRF etc during any disaster.

2. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the MoU was signed between National Disaster Management Authority, Government of India & Government of Tamil Nadu in terms of approval of the competent authority for implementation of National Disaster Management Services (NDMS). As per the MoU, Role and Responsibilities of National disaster Management Authority(NDMA) Government of Tamil Nadu are as follows:-

1. National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA)

- ❖ Provide necessary budgetary support for timely execution of the project
- ❖ Shall coordinate with states to provide lifeline buildings as far as possible
- ❖ Shall provide one Field Engineer at each location for a period of 12 months
- ❖ Shall monitor and review the performance of the project periodically

- ❖ Will also act as interface between the State and BSNL
- ❖ Provide all possible help for smooth and efficient functioning of the EOCs.

2. Government of Tamil Nadu

- ❖ Shall provide locations where EOCs are to be along with the Name of Nodal officers, Communications Address, Telephone Numbers with STD Code, and also mobile number as well as email address
- ❖ The State Government / District Administration will ensure availability of electricity, water, air conditioning & required personnel including the physical infrastructure at the respective EOCs.
- ❖ State will take over the assets so created in this project and would deploy manpower as required for efficient and smooth functioning of the EOC
- ❖ State will take on the legacy after two years i.e., one year warranty period and AMC for next one year/
- ❖ Shall provide all possible help to the Implementing Agency for implementation of the project so as to ensure timely creation of connectivity and establishment of EOC
- ❖ Shall ensure Security of Data so created in the functioning of the project.
- ❖ Shall coordinate the Training on ICT Infrastructure of the project
- ❖ shall be responsible for Call charges of PSTN, GSM, VSAT, INMARSAT connectivities.
- ❖ Shall cater for platform provisioning earthing., monkey cage (if required) clear line of site by trimming of branches / trees etc for installation and function of VSAT
- ❖ Shall provide lifeline buildings for EOCS as far as possible.

3. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated that the as per the MoU signed between National disaster Management Authority, Government of India & Government of Tamil Nadu "State Government shall be responsible for Call charges of PSTN, GSM, VSAT, INMARSAT connectivities" after two years. Further, in the minutes of the meeting on NDMS Pilot Project held on 19th to 21st of February 2019, It has been stated that as per the MoU, payment of Bandwidth/Internet charges for VSAT, its AMC and recurrent charges of I-SAT phone are required to be borne by the states/UT with effect from 1st April 2019. The Divisional Engineer, BSNL, Bangalore has sent the payment details of Bandwidth/Internet Charges for VSAT as follows:-

4. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested to sanction a sum of Rs.11,91,496/-

(Eleven Lakh Ninety One Thousand Four Hundred and Ninety Six Only) from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards Bandwidth/ Internet Charges for VSAT in 4 NDMS sites (SEOC, Chennai, DEOC's, Kancheepuram, Tiruvallur and Tirunelveli).

5. The Government after careful consideration, accept the Proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of the State Executive Committee accord sanction a sum of Rs.11,91,496/- (Eleven Lakh Ninety One Thousand Four Hundred and Ninety Six Only) from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards Bandwidth/ Internet Charges for VSAT in 4 NDMS sites (SEOC, Chennai, DEOC's, Kancheepuram, Tiruvallur and Tirunelveli).

6. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2245 Relief on Account of Natural Calamities – 80 General – 800 Other Expenditure – State Expenditure – AF Formation of Emergency Operation Centres in Sub-Divisional Offices – 305 office Expenses – 01 Telephone Changes."

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.11,91,496/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by Specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021. The Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to sent necessary proposal for inclusion of the expenditure in Revised Estimate 2020-2021 and also to send necessary draft Explanatory Note for specific inclusion in the supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail at appropriate time.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.351/Deputy Secretary to Government(B)/Finance (Revenue)/2020, dated 05.12.2020 with A.S.L.No.1017 (One thousand and seventeen)
