Disaster Management – Announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 19.10.2020 – Heavy rains and unprecedented floods in the city of Hyderabad and in certain Districts of Telangana - Sending of 1,00,000 Nos. of blankets and 20,000 Nos. of mats as relief material to Telangana State – Sanction of Rs.3,63,40,000/- from Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund for supply of Blankets and Mats – Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the reference first read above the Hon'ble Chief Minister has made announcement to provide a contribution of Rs.10 crore to Telangana State from the Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund towards relief and to send 1,00,000 Nos. of blankets and 20,000 Nos. of mats as relief material to Telangana State in view of the extensive damages caused due to heavy rains and unprecedented floods in Hyderabad city and in certain districts of Telangana State.

2. In the Government order second read above, the Government have sanctioned an amount of Rs.10.00 crore (Rupees Ten crore only) from the Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund to the Telangana Chief Minister's Relief Fund.

3. In the reference third read above, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that, the Managing Director, Co-optex and the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board were requested to furnish the total cost of 1.00 lakh Nos. of blankets and 20,000 Nos. of mats including the transportation costs to Hyderabad city

respectively and make arrangements to procure and transport the materials in a convoy immediately. In response to that, the Managing Director, Co-optex has informed that the total cost of 1.00 lakh Nos. of blankets including the transportation charges works out to Rs.3,34,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crores and Thirty Four Lakhs only) {Rs.3,30,00,000/- (1,00,000 blankets x Rs.330/- each (including GST) + Rs.4,00,000/- (Transportation Charges)= Rs.3,34,00,000/-}. It has also been informed that necessary arrangements are being made to effect the supply of the blankets to Hyderabad in Telangana State before 24.10.2020.

4. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board has stated that the cost of one number of mat including the transportation charges is Rs.140/- + 5% GST and the total cost towards supply of 20,000 mats including transportation charges is Rs.29,40,000/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Lakhs and Forty Thousand) [Rs.28,00,000/- (20,000 mats x Rs.140/- each) + Rs.1,40,000/- (5% GST on Rs.28,00,000/-)= Rs.29,40,000/-]. In his letter dated 21.10.2020 it has also been informed that they would be in a position to supply the required number of 20,000 mats on the date and place indicated by the Government.

5. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also informed that the total cost towards the supply and transportation of 1.00 lakhs Nos. of blankets and 20,000 Nos. of mats as relief materials to Hyderabad City of Telangana State in view of the extensive damages caused due to the heavy rainfall and unprecedented floods in the Hyderabad City of Telangana State works out to Rs.3,63,40,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Sixty Three Lakhs and Forty Thousand only) as detailed below:-

The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further informed that the expenditure incurred towards relief and temporary restoration works in the event of a disaster pertaining to this State alone could be met out from the State Disaster Response Fund and hence the expenditure in the instant case, i.e. providing relief materials to Telangana State could not be met out from the State Disaster Response Fund.

7. Therefore, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has requested the Government to sanction a total sum of Rs.3,63,40,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Sixty Three Lakhs and Forty Thousand only) i.e. Rs.3,34,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crore and Thirty Four Lakhs only) to

the Managing Director, Co-optex and Rs.29,40,000/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Lakhs and Forty Thousand) to the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board either from State Funds or from Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund towards supply and transportation of 1.00 lakh Nos. of blankets and 20,000 Nos. of mats respectively to Hyderabad City in Telangana State as relief materials in view of the extensive damages caused due to the heavy rainfall and unprecedented floods in the Hyderabad City of Telangana State.

8. Based on the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 19.10.2020, the Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and accord sanction a sum of Rs.3,63,40,000/- (Rupees Three crore sixty three lakh and forty thousand only) i.e. Rs.3,34,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crore and Thirty Four Lakh only) to the Managing Director, Co-optex and Rs.29,40,000/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Lakh and Forty Thousand only) to the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board from the Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund towards supply and transportation of 1.00 lakh Nos. of blankets and 20,000 Nos. of mats respectively to Hyderabad City in Telangana State as relief materials in view of the extensive damages caused due to the heavy rainfall and unprecedented floods in the Hyderabad City of Telangana State.

9. The Joint Secretary to Government and Treasurer, Finance[CMPRF] Department is requested to send a cheque for an amount of Rs.3,63,40,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Sixty Three Lakhs and Forty Thousand only) in the name of the Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration as sanctioned in the paragraph 8 above.

10. The Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to disburse the amount as sanctioned in para-8 above after obtaining the original stamped receipt from the Managing Director, Co-optex and the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board. The stamped receipt obtained in original, duly signed by an officer with their official seal, not below the rank of Tahsildar should be sent to Finance (Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund) Department under intimation to this department.
