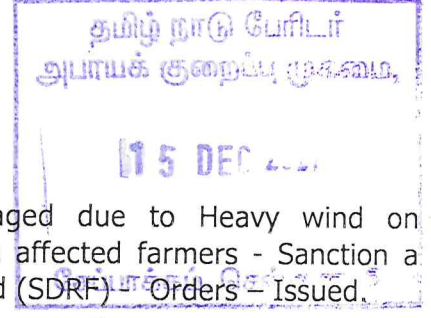




**ABSTRACT**



Disaster Management - Agricultural crops were damaged due to Heavy wind on 10.04.2020 in Perambalur District - Input subsidy to the affected farmers - Sanction a sum of Rs.24,72,930/- under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) Orders - Issued.

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**ORDER:-**

In the letter third read above, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the District Collector, Perambalur has sent a proposal for input subsidy to the affected farmers in Perambalur District whose agricultural crops were damaged due to heavy wind on 10.04.2020 and requested to sanction a sum of Rs.24,72,930/- under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) as detailed below:-

The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the Director of Agriculture has also recommended the proposal and the same has been examined in detail with reference to State Disaster Response Fund norms prescribed in G.O.(Ms) No.380, Revenue Department, dated 27.10.2015 and G.O.(Ms) No.246, Revenue and Disaster Management [DM.3(2)] Department, dated 03.08.2017. The proposal is submitted under the item "Agriculture" in S.No.b(ii) of G.O.(Ms) No.246, Revenue Department, dated 03.08.2017 and there is provision for sanction of funds from under State Disaster Response Fund towards input subsidy for crop loss which is more than 33% (for Agriculture crops, Horticulture crops and Plantation crops) due to disasters.

3. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated that the proposal of District Collector, Perambalur is found eligible for sanction of input subsidy under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) and has requested the Government to issue orders by sanctioning a sum of Rs.24,72,930/- under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards the input subsidy to the affected farmers of Perambalur District whose agriculture crops were damaged due to heavy wind on 10.04.2020.

4. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of the State Executive Committee, accord sanction a sum of **Rs.24,72,930/- (Rupees Twenty four lakh seventy two thousand nine hundred and thirty only)** under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards the input subsidy to the affected farmers in Perambalur District whose agriculture crops were damaged due to heavy wind on 10.04.2020.

5. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

**"2245-Relief on account of Natural Calamities - 02-Floods, Cyclones etc., 114-Assistance to Farmers for purchase of Agricultural inputs- State's Expenditure - AA-Subsidy to Small and Marginal Farmers for Agricultural Inputs due to Flood – 311-Subsidies 01-Individual based subsidy. (IFHRMS DPC: 2245 02 114 AA 31101)**

6. Necessary additional funds of **Rs.24,72,930/-** will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2021-2022 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2021-2022. Pending provision of such funds, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration is directed to include the above item of expenditure sanctioned, while sending the budget proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2021-2022 and also send necessary draft explanatory notes for specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2021-2022 to Finance (Revenue/BG-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.51985/Finance (Revenue)/2021, dated 25.11.2021 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.941 [Nine hundred and forty one].
