ORDER:

In the reference 6th read above, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has submitted that in Ariyalur, Erode, Karur, Krishnagiri, Kanniyakumari, Namakkal, Pudukottai, Salem, Thanjavur, Theni, Tirunelveli, Tiruppur, Villupuram and Virudhunagar Districts, the Horticultural and Agricultural crops were damaged due to heavy rain, Strongwind, Whirlwind and Galewind during the year 2019.

The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops and Director of Agriculture have also recommended the above proposals sent by the respective District Collectors

2. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has further stated that the proposals received from the District Collectors along with the recommendation of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops and Director of Agriculture have been examined with State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) norms prescribed in the Government orders 1st and 2nd read above. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also stated that the item "**Agriculture**" in Sl.No.5 B in the Government order 1st

read above and under the item "**Agriculture**" in Sl. No. b (ii) in the Government order 2nd read above, there is provision for sanction of funds from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards input subsidy for crop loss which is 33% and above (for Agriculture Crops, Horticulture Crops and Plantation Crops) due to disasters. As per the above said provisions stipulated in the Government orders 1st and 2nd read above, proposals of the 14 District collectors are found eligible for sanction of input subsidy under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).

3. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration has therefore requested to sanction a sum of Rs.1,57,78,990/-under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards input subsidy to the affected farmers whose Horticultural and Agricultural crops were damaged due to rain, Strong wind, Whirlwind and Gale wind during the year 2017-2019 in Ariyalur, Erode, Karur, Krishnagiri, Kanniyakumari, Namakkal, Pudukottai, Salem, Thanjavur, Theni, Tirunelveli, Tiruppur, Villupuram and Virudhunagar Districts.

4. The Government, after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and based on the approval of State Executive Committee accord sanction a sum of Rs.1,57,78,990/- (Rupees One Crore Fifty Seven Lakh Seventy Eight Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety only) under the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) towards input subsidy to the affected farmers whose Horticultural and Agricultural crops were damaged due to rain, Strongwind, Whirlwind and Galewind during the year 2017-2019 in 14 districts viz. Ariyalur, Erode, Karur, Krishnagiri, Kanniyakumari, Namakkal, Pudukottai, Salem, Thanjavur, Theni, Tirunelveli, Tiruppur, Villupuram and Virudhunagar.

5. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2245 Relief on Account of Natural Calamities 02 Flood, Cyclones, etc., - 114 Assistance to farmers for purchase of Agricultural inputs – State Expenditure – AA Subsidy to small and Marginal farmers for Agricultural inputs due to Flood – 311 subsidies – 01 Individual Based subsidy.

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.1,57,78,990/- will be provided in FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds, the Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislative Assembly by Specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021. The Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to sent necessary proposal for inclusion on the expenditure in FMA 2020-2021 and also to send necessary draft Explanatory

Note for specific inclusion in the supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/Revenue) Department without fail at appropriate time.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.2026 /Finance (Revenue)/2021, dated.27.01.2021 with A.S.L.No.1546 (one thousand five hundred and forty six).
